## **TECHNICAL SAFETY POLICY**



The Management of **HISPACOLD** is aware of the importance of safety in all working areas and sectors. Therefore, it is establishing strategic guidelines for the following activities, alongside the ISO 45001 certification of its Health and Safety Management system, and expressing them in this **Technical Safety Policy**:

Design, Manufacture, Assembly and After-Sales Service of Air Conditioning Equipment for passenger transport.

The **Technical Safety Policy** aims to establish a strategy to ensure that our air conditioning systems will be safe for all our users, from customers, to operators, maintenance staff, and our workers, reducing the potential risks to a minimum or eliminating them, and always keeping them in mind in the Design and Development process, as well as in the production process.

The effectiveness of the safety of equipment, and the methods used in their manufacture to minimize or eliminate potential risks, is measured and assessed for each railway project in a customized manner, using existing information from each specific project, as well as lessons learned from our project history. Product safety indicators are used and maintained in order to guarantee that the assessment and mitigation of risks is carried out in an effective, efficient manner.

The **Technical Safety Policy** establishes the following as its objectives:



A. Safe Design and Development of the equipment through compliance with the standards and regulations that apply to the equipment developed, and also through compliance with the customers' expectations.



B. Availability of tooling and safe means of production through compliance with the standards and regulations that apply to the job roles in the production area.



C. Commitment to continuous improvement, introducing objectives for monitoring and lessons learned, trying to prevent malfunctions and communicating with all the HISPACOLD stakeholders.

The Quality and Environmental Director is responsible for making this Policy available in a permanent format, so that it can be reviewed by any stakeholders and members of the public who request it.
